OVERVIEW

- The Women in Social Impact / Changemaker Award recognises a woman who has made a powerful and measurable difference in her community or society through impactful initiatives, advocacy, or social entrepreneurship. This award honours women who are passionate changemakers, working to solve social, cultural, environmental, or economic challenges—whether through grassroots efforts, nonprofit work, or purpose-driven businesses. These leaders inspire collective action and advocate for positive transformation on both local and global scales.

ELIGIBILITY

- Open to women-identifying individuals involved in social impact work (nonprofits, activism, policy, social enterprise, etc.)
- Must demonstrate clear outcomes or progress in addressing a social

QUALITATIVE CRITERIA

- Ability to mobilise communities or inspire movements
- Demonstrates empathy, equity, and inclusive leadership
- Resilience in overcoming barriers or resistance
- Builds partnerships and collaborations for collective good
